

## INSTALLATION

- Compatible with most telephone systems including P.B.X.
- Easy to install
- Select switch (under the Selector Cover)
- Handset/headset switch and mute switch
- 5. RJ-9 Modular

# Connecting Handset Cord

## **OPERATION**

- 1. Use handset as needed.
- 2. Using the headset
- Remove the telephone handset from the cradle of the telephone and dial as usual.
- b. Press the Switch Button.
- To receive a call using the headset, just lift the handset and press the Switch Button.
- d. To disconnect a call, just hang up/place the handset on the cradle.

- Mute: Press the Mute Button to ensure that your voice cannot be heard by the caller at the other end of the line.
- Adjust the headset microphone by moving it closer to your mouth (ideal position is a 2-finger distance from your mouth to the microphone boom).
- Adjust the volume level on the right side.

## CHECK

Check that your handset/headset has been switched on, all cords are connected properly, and that the correct channel has been selected.

### **SAFETY**

For your own safety, this product should only be used with CE and ROHS approved equipment. Using this headset with non-approved equipment would void the warranty of this product.
